The Shreveport Fire Department would like to remind our citizens of Shreveport and surrounding areas to take the time to check and change the batteries in your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors. Working smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors increases your chance of escaping when an emergency occurs. The most common cause of non-working alarms are old, missing or not properly installed batteries. Make sure you check your alarm after installation.
