Man faces felony charges after car plows through residence



A Shreveport man faces a number of serious charges after he allegedly drove a car through an east Shreveport residence Wednesday afternoon.

Just after 12:15 p.m. on April 13, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to a home located in the 700 block of East 73rd Street relative to a stabbing. Upon officer's arrival at the home, it was discovered an adult female was on scene suffering minor injuries after allegedly being attacked by a man who intentionally drove his car through the front door of her residence after being denied entry. After gaining access inside the now heavily damaged home, the man located the woman and reportedly physically assaulted her. At some point during the assault, the woman managed to arm herself with a sharp edged object and stabbed the man once in the upper body.

Following the physical altercation, the suspect, positively identified as 29 year old Vincent L. Henderson Jr. of Shreveport, fled the scene, driving off in the very car he used to drive through the home. No other persons inside the home were injured. Authorities, within minutes of the initial incident, located Henderson along with the car he was driving, at a residence located in the 2700 block of Amherst Street in Shreveport's Sunset Acres subdivision. Henderson was taken into police custody at the Amherst Street home and transported via ambulance to University Health where he was treated for a single stab wound to the upper body. Henderson was last listed in stable condition at the medical center. Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives were notified of the matter and responded to the scene, launching a subsequent inquiry into the incident. At current, Henderson faces charges of Aggravated Criminal Property Damage, Home Invasion and Simple Battery. Following his release from the hospital, Henderson will be booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
