Suspects sought in early morning shooting

A Shreveport man is recovering while authorities seek suspects following an early morning shooting at a west Shreveport residence Thursday morning.

Just after 6:00 a.m. on May 5, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a home located in the 3300 block of Darien Street relative to a shooting. When officers arrived at the home, the victim, 29 year old Quincy Jackson was suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the lower extremities. Jackson was taken to University Health via ambulance for injuries considered by medical staff, to be non life-threatening.

Shreveport Police detectives arrived at the scene of the crime where an immediate investigation was initiated. Preliminary findings suggests Jackson was standing outside the home when an older model, white vehicle, possibly a Ford Pinto, drove down the block and it's occupants began to fire multiple shots at him. During the shooting, Jackson was struck. The home in which Jackson was standing in front of, was struck numerous times, in addition to at least four other residences along the same street. Authorities are seeking to identify the suspects in the case, who were all reportedly wearing coverings over their faces. Officers did manage to locate a semi-automatic weapon at the crime scene, along with over a dozen spent shell casings.
