Woman injured; suspect jailed in early morning shooting

A woman remains hospitalized, while an alleged suspect sits behind bars in an early morning shooting in west Shreveport Wednesday.

Just after 2:00 a.m. on May 11, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol were dispatched to a residence located in the 3100 block of Regent Street relative to a shooting. Once officers arrived at the home, it was learned the victim, adult female Victoria Mosley was suffering injury after reportedly being shot by a known suspect. Mosley was taken via ambulance to University Health where she was treated for her injuries and is expected to survive.

As authorities began their inquiry into the shooting, they gathered information suggesting Mosley and her live-in boyfriend, identified as 28 year old Bobby Tyler, were engaged in a verbal argument, when at some point during the exchange, Tyler allegedly armed himself with a high powered rifle and shot Mosley. During a search of the residence, officers located the weapon suspected used in the crime along with suspected narcotics. Officers were able to detain Tyler on scene at the home and transported him to Shreveport Police headquarters for interviews. Following subsequent interviews with detectives, Tyler was charged with a single count of Attempted Second Degree Murder, Possession of Schedule I, II, Triggerlock, and Obstruction of Justice. As the investigation continues, investigators expect more charges will be forthcoming in the case. Tyler was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
