Local man faces charges in stabbing



Suspect Bobby Williams, Jr.

A Shreveport man now faces Simple Battery charges following a stabbing which sent him to the hospital Friday afternoon.

Just after 3:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrolmen were called to a residence located in the 400 block of Apache Trail relative to a stabbing. As officers arrived at the home, contact was made with an adult female who advised authorities she had been physically assaulted by a man still inside the residence.

Police officers were able to detain the alleged suspect identified as, 27 year old Bobby Williams Jr., on scene at the home. Preliminary information suggests, Williams and the woman were engaged in a verbal dispute which turned physical. It is alleged the woman armed herself with a sharp edged object amid an attack at the hands of Williams. During the melee, Williams received a minor cut to mid-section and was treated at University Hospital. Williams was charged with a single count of Simple Battery. The woman, who received only minor injuries, was not charged in the matter.
