Suspect sought in shooting following altercation

Shreveport Police are investigating an overnight shooting which sent a local woman to the hospital overnight.

Shortly before Midnight on May 31 2016, Shreveport Police were called to a home in the 3700 block of Mayfield Street relative to a reported shooting. On scene at the home, authorities located the victim, 23 year old Calisha Hunt, suffering an apparent gunshot wound to the arm. Hunt was taken to University Health via ambulance, where she is expected to recover from her injuries.

Investigators arrived on scene at the crime, launching an investigation into what occurred. Information gathered during the preliminary stage of the inquiry suggests Hunt was engaged in a physical altercation with a group of other females known to her. It is alleged the involved parties had been engaged in a longstanding feud, which culminated when a number of female subjects arrived at the home of Hunt to fight. It was alleged that at the height of the melee, Hunt was injured by a male suspect who produced a handgun and fired multiple rounds, one of which is believed to have struck Hunt. The search for the suspect, described as a heavy set black male with dread locks and those persons involved in the brawl, remain underway at this hour.
