Suspect jailed in connection with fatal Legardy Street shooting

Shreveport Police have arrested a man in connection with a shooting which left one man dead and two others injured in north Shreveport last month.

Back on May 23, 2016, Shreveport Police were called to a home in the 1900 block of Legardy Street relative to a shooting. During that time, officers learned 55 year old Michael L. Hamilton had been fatally shot along with 33 year old Erion Hamilton and Zackery T. Winn, who were both injured during a dispute which ended in an exchange of gunfire.

Since the launch of their investigation, detectives have worked tirelessly to identify those persons responsible for the incident. On Wednesday June 1, 2016, those efforts led investigators to interview 21 year old LilTerrance A. Pierce in connection with the shooting. Based on information gathered amid continuous examination of evidence, authorities have linked Pierce to the crime. Following interviews with Pierce, he was charged with a single count of illegal use of a weapon. Pierce was booked into the Shreveport City Jail. The investigation into the case remains active.
