Shreveport Police Investigate Shooting Injuring Juvenile

Shreveport Police are investigating an overnight shooting which sent a 16-year-old juvenile to the hospital.

On June 8, 2016, at approximately 8:08 pm, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to Fire Station 6 regarding a juvenile who arrived at the location suffering a gunshot wound to the foot. Officers learned in speaking to the victim, he was present in the 1600 block of Knox Street when he reported hearing gunshots. It was alleged the victim was shot by persons who fled the scene after firing more than a dozen rounds. The juvenile was taken to University Health via ambulance for injuries considered non-life threatening.

Shreveport Police investigators responded to the scene of the crime and launched an immediate investigation. Evidence gathered on scene suggested the suspects fired numerous rounds which were heard by nearby residents. At current, there are no suspects identified in the matter, which remains under investigation.
