Suspect sought, accused in shooting

Shreveport Police detectives are seeking to locate a man who they believe is responsible for a Wednesday morning shooting which left another man injured.

Shortly before 3:00 a.m. on June 29, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 6600 block of Burke Street regarding a shooting in which the victim was shot once in the leg. After being taken to University Health, it was determined the victim, 29 year old Vashiloh Willis, suffered non-life-threatening injuries.

Investigators assigned to the case have since gathered information and evidence which has linked 31 year old Robbie Johnson of the 5900 block of Henderson Avenue in Shreveport to the crime. Authorities have since procured a warrant for the arrest of Johnson who now faces a single charge each of, Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Illegal Use of a Weapon. It is believed Johnson shot Willis following a verbal dispute between the men. The exact nature of the argument is unknown.
