Arrest warrant obtained for suspect in shooting of local man



Suspect: KDarius Hines

Shreveport Police detectives have identified the suspect they believe is responsible for a shooting which seriously injured a Shreveport man Wednesday.

Back on July 6, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to University Health hospital regarding a male patient who arrived by private vehicle, in the emergency room suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the upper torso. The man was identified as 26 year old Tyrell Diggs of Shreveport. Diggs was treated for his injuries which were described as serious; however, he is expected to survive.

During the course of the investigation into the shooting, authorities learned Diggs was present at the Raceway gas station in the 200 block of East 70th Street when he and another male engaged in a dispute of an unknown nature. At the height of the dispute, it is alleged the unknown male produced a firearm, shooting Diggs multiple times before fleeing the scene. Since the launch of the investigation, information and evidence has led authorities to name 26 year old KDarius Hines as the suspect in the shooting. Hines is wanted on a single count of Attempted Second Degree Murder, with a bond amount of \$250,000.00.
