Four shot; one dies in overnight shooting

Shreveport Police detectives are still searching for clues and the suspects responsible for a shooting which left one man dead and three others injured in west Shreveport Thursday evening.

Just after 11:30 p.m. on July 7, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the a home in the 3800 block of Murvon Street relative to a shooting. As officers arrived at the scene, they discovered several victims suffering gunshot wounds. In all, four victims were shot, with one man, 40 year old Dimingo Rhines of Shreveport, suffering a fatal gunshot wound to the chest. Cortez Bright, 19, Kenaz Hines, 48, and a 17 year old male victim were transported from the crime scene, to University Health for treatment of their injuries which were considered to be non life-threatening.

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives were dispatched to the scene of the crime and immediately began an ongoing probe into the deadly encounter. Based on preliminary information gathered at the scene of the crime, it appears the shooting victims were standing outside of the Murvon Street home when a silver sedan, possible a Chevrolet Impala, drove past the residence and engaged in what authorities believe to be an exchange of gunfire with persons standing outside. Multiple shell casings were recovered from the crime scene. Rhines death marks the 19th homicide thus far in 2016.
