Motorist dies in single vehicle crash

A Shreveport woman has died following a single vehicle crash in west Shreveport Tuesday afternoon.

Just after 5:00 p.m. on July 19, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a stretch of Terry Bradshaw Passway near East Bert Kouns Industrial Loop regarding a single vehicle crash. As officers arrived at the crash site, it was learned that the victim of the crash was taken via ambulance to University Health hospital, after the 2014 Ford Focus she was driving, left the roadway for unknown reasons.

Based on information gathered at the scene, it is believed the driver, and sole occupant of the car, 72 year old Delores Harrison of Shreveport, was traveling west bound of East Bert Kouns Industrial Loop, when she entered the on-ramp to Terry Bradshaw Passway (3132 west) and traveled off the roadway. Harrison's vehicle rolled and came to a rest on all four tires. Harrison, who suffered serious injuries, later died at University Health hospital. Shreveport Police Crash investigators were called to the scene of the accident and are in the process of determining what events led to the crash. Impairment on the part of the driver is not expected. The crash remains under investigation.
