Suspect named in shooting of local teen



Suspect: Chaddrick Thomas

Shreveport Police investigators have named a suspect in a shooting which sent a local teen to the hospital.

Back on July 17, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to a shooting involving a local teen which authorities believe occurred at Lee Hedges Stadium in the 6000 block of Kings Highway around 6:15 p.m. on July 17, 2016. Officers located the injured 17 year old white male, who reportedly drove from the stadium, to the intersection of Southfield Road at Youree Drive after suffering a gunshot wound to the upper body.

In investigator's probe of the incident, it was learned that the victim and another male, were allegedly engaged in the sale of illegal narcotics when a dispute between he and another man ensued. It is believed at that time, the teen was shot. Since the investigation began, authorities have gathered information linking 19 year old Chaddrick Thomas of Shreveport to the crime. Authorities have procured a warrant for the arrest of Thomas, charging him with a single count of Attempted First Degree Murder. Bond in the matter has been set at \$100,000.00.
