Crime Stoppers tip corrals attempted burglary suspect



Suspect: Charles Phillips, Jr.

A Shreveport man wanted in connection with a vehicle burglary, lands behind bars after a Crime Stoppers tip led to his arrest.

Back on May 24, 2016, Shreveport Police were advised by the owner of a Chevrolet pickup truck that a male suspect was seen attempting to burglarize his vehicle. As the owner confronted the man, he fled the scene of the crime on foot, after unsuccessfully gaining entry into the automobile.

Although the suspect managed to elude capture, it was learned that a portion of man's devious deed was captured on surveillance. The surveillance video was released to the media, which ultimately led to him being identified as 43 year old Charles Phillips Jr., of the 6100 block of Newton-Abbott Drive in Shreveport. Upon authorities contact with Phillips, it was learned he was the person captured on the video surveillance attempting to burglarize the vehicle. For his alleged role in the crime, Phillips was arrested and charged with a single count of Attempted Simple Burglary of a Vehicle.
