## **Man injured in weekend stabbing**

Shreveport Police are investigating a weekend stabbing which sent a Shreveport man to the hospital

Just before 2:30 a.m. on July 31, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to a home located in the 4200 block of Chamberlain Drive, relative to a reported stabbing. As officers arrived at the residence, they located what appeared to be a crime scene; however, there was no victim present. Moments later, authorities were contacted by medical staff at Willis-Knighton hospital's north location, regarding a man who arrived via private vehicle, in the emergency room suffering a stab wound to the leg. The man was treated for injuries considered to be non-life-threatening.

In speaking with the man, it was determined he had been present at the Chamberlain Drive home when he suffered injury. Due to the man's condition at the time he was contacted by officers, communication with the man was extremely difficult. Efforts to immediately ascertain what took place at the residence prior to officer arrival were delayed; however, authorities are confident the elements of the incident will emerge and become clearer as the investigation continues.
