## **Woman injured after residence struck by gunfire**

A Shreveport woman is recovering from a gunshot wound after her residence came under gunfire over the weekend.

Just after 3:00 a.m. on July 31, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a home located in the 2600 block of Lakehurst Avenue relative to a home which had been struck by gunfire.

As officers arrived at the scene, contact was made with the adult female victim, who advised that she was asleep when she was awakened by the sound of gunfire. The woman fortunately suffered only minor injuries after receiving a graze wound to the leg. It appears the home was struck over a dozen times. At current there have been no suspects identified in the shooting which remains under investigation.
