Shooting on Interstate 20 sends woman to hospital

A woman is recovering after being shot while driving down a stretch of Interstate 20 over the weekend.

Just after 4:15 a.m. on July 31, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to Willis-Knighton hospital's north location regarding a woman who arrived at the hospital suffering gunshot wounds to both legs. The woman drove herself to the hospital after allegedly being shot while traveling down Interstate 20 heading west near Greenwood Road.

Information gathered during investigators probe of the incident revealed the woman was driving when a silver or white colored vehicle of an unknown year make or model, pulled alongside her and fired a number of shots at her vehicle. The woman was the only victim of injury during the ordeal. Investigators are working tirelessly to identify and apprehend the person or persons responsible for the shooting.
