Warrant obtained in burglary of political office building



Suspect: Cary Baylor

Shreveport Police detectives have identified a suspect in the vandalism and burglary of an office building belonging to a local State Representative.

Back on August 1, 2016, just after 9:00 a.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the 3200 block of Hollywood Avenue relative to a break-in at the political offices of Louisiana State Representative Barbara Norton. Since the launch of the investigation into the incident, authorities have procured a warrant for the arrest of the man they believe is responsible for the acts.

Based on evidence and information gathered during the on-going inquiry, Cary Baylor 60, of Shreveport, has been named as the suspect in the incidents. Baylor is now sought on charges to include Burglary and Un-authorized entry of a Place of Business. Bond in the matter has been set at \$100,000.00.
