Shreveport Police investigate shooting

A Shreveport man remains hospitalized after being injured in a shooting in north Shreveport. Just after 7:00 p.m. on August 17, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to Willis Knighton North hospital after an adult male arrived at the hospital's emergency room via private vehicle. Simultaneously officers had been dispatched to the Cherokee Park neighborhood in reference to a "shots fired" call. A crime scene was located in the 400 block of Mohawk Trail near the intersection of E. Algonquin.

Shreveport Police Detectives launched an immediate investigation into the matter and learned that 19 year old Cameron Matthews was driving through the neighborhood when a black male suspect with a dark hoodie on stepped out and began firing at his vehicle. The victim had an injury to his head that is non life threatening and his expected to make a full recovery.
