Shreveport Police investigate fatal shooting

A Shreveport man has died after being fatally wounded overnight in a shooting in Shreveport's Agurs subdivision.

Just after 3:15 a.m. on September 24, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to an apartment home located in the 2000 block of North Hearne Avenue relative to a loud noise complaint. When officers arrived at the scene, it was discovered that a male victim was deceased inside the apartment, the victim of an apparent gunshot wound to the head. The man was identified as 20 year old Jayveon Arthur.

Shreveport Police detectives along with crime scene investigators responded to the location of the shooting and began an immediate inquiry. Preliminary information gathered on scene revealed Arthur was one of multiple people inside the apartment when multiple shots fired from outside the apartment, passed through a window of the home. Authorities believe one of those shots was the one that mortally wounded Arthur. No one else inside the apartment sustained any injury. Investigators have not identified the person or persons responsible for the shooting and remain hard at work at this hour searching for clues in the tragic incident. There is a reward being offered through Shreveport Crime Stoppers for information leading to an arrest in the case.
