Suspects sought in drive-by shooting

A Shreveport man is dead and two others are recovering after being shot in a drive-by shooting Friday afternoon.

Shortly before 1:00 p.m. on October 28, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 900 block of Babylon Street relative to a call of "shots fired". As officers arrived at the scene, it was learned three men had suffered gunshot wounds. According to preliminary information gathered at the scene, a group of males were standing near a residence located in the 900 block of Babylon Street, when a blue or silver colored sedan, occupied by multiple males drove out front of the home. It was reported, multiple suspects exited the vehicle armed with guns and began firing, subsequently striking a male standing in the front lawn, along with two other male victims who were reportedly standing in close proximity to the home. Following the shooting, the suspects fled the scene, driving away in the sedan.

One victim was taken by private auto to a local hospital, while two other shooting victims were taken by ambulance. Of the three shooting victims, 21 year old Quincy T. Randle suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased shortly on arrival at University Health hospital. Michael Cooper, 21, and Tamario Jenkins, 20, each suffered non life-threatening injuries. Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit were called to the scene and immediately began an investigation into the shooting. Authorities are working tirelessly at this hour to gather details in the tragic ordeal, and are asking anyone with information about the shooting to contact Crime Stoppers at (318) 673-7373 or visit their website at www.lockem.org Crime Stoppers is offering a \$1,000.00 reward for information leading to the arrest of those responsible for the crime.
