Suspect sought in double slaying



Suspect: Arthur Anderson

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators are seeking to locate and apprehend a local man, who based on information and evidence obtained, is allegedly responsible for the shooting deaths of two people Saturday evening in west Shreveport.

Just before 10:30 p.m. on November 19, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 4000 block of Crosby Street relative to a shooting. As authorities arrived at the scene, they discovered two people suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the upper body. One victim, a 37 year old male, was declared deceased on the scene after being shot while he was apparently a passenger inside a vehicle driven by the second victim, a 27 year old woman who died shortly after her transport via ambulance, to University Health hospital.

Based on preliminary information, it is believed the victims were traveling westbound in the 4000 block of Crosby Street, when the vehicle they were in left the roadway and came to rest in a ditch along the side of the road. It is believed at that time; a male suspect approached the vehicle and fired several rounds from a handgun, striking both victims. Authorities believe the suspect fled the scene immediately following the cowardly act, and remains at large. Working tirelessly, investigators have gathered information leading them to obtain a warrant for the arrest of 25 year old Arthur Anderson in connection with the murders. Police believe Anderson and the female victim were at some point, romantically involved. Anderson, of the 2700 block of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, is now charged with two counts of Second degree murder and should be considered armed and dangerous. Bond in the matter has been set at \$750,000.00. Crimestoppers is offering a reward of \$1,000.00 for information leading to the arrest of Anderson.
