SFD Responds to Evening Fire at Cornerstone Apartments

The Shreveport Fire Department responded to the Conerstone Apartments in the 100 Blk. of Southfield Road at 6:02 pm for a possible apartment fire. Fire units arrived on scene at 6:07 pm and reported smoke showing from the roof.

It took 11-units and 27-firefighters to locate the fire and bring the situation under control. Firefighters located the fire in a wall between 4-apartments. The building involved had 10 upstairs units and 10 downstairs apartemnts. All occupants of the building have been temporarily relocated by the apartment manager until repairs can be made to the units.

The four involved units sustained minor water damage and the fire damage was confined to a void space between the individual apartment units. There were no injuries reported and the fire remains under investigation at this time.
