## **Suspects sought in robbery of local eatery**

The search is on for a pair of suspects who committed a robbery of the Southfield Grill restaurant early Wednesday morning.

Shortly after 4:00 a.m. on November 30, 2016, Shreveport Police officers were called to the Southfield Grill eatery located in the 300 block of Southfield Road relative to a robbery of the business. As officers arrived at the crime scene, information was given to officers suggesting that while preparing to open the store for business, two suspects were observed inside the establishment wearing coverings over their faces and gloves on their hands. The suspects, described as having short and medium builds respectively, forced employees inside the cooler in the business, not before robbing one of the victims of a small amount of cash.

The suspects fled from the business on foot, taking the businesses cash register with them. Surveillance photos of the suspects were taken and are being circulated in hopes of identifying those person responsible for the crime. There were no injuries reported.
