Two charged in theft of parcel



Suspect: Cassie Jordan

A Shreveport woman and a local juvenile now face criminal charges in connection with their alleged involvement in stealing items from the front porch of a South Highlands residence Friday morning.

Just after 8:30 a.m. on December 2, 2016, Shreveport Police patrolmen were called to a residence located in the 1700 block of Morovia Street relative to a theft. Upon contact with the home owner, it was learned that a woman driving a black SUV pulled in front of the residence, at which time, a juvenile female exited the vehicle, walked up to the home's front door and took a package belonging to the residence.

Upon making off with the package, the juvenile returned to the vehicle, which drove away from the scene. Unbeknownst to the duo, the devious deed was captured on surveillance video, providing authorities useful information making it possible to track down the suspects allegedly responsible for the brazen act. In a follow-up investigation, authorities learned the identity of the driver of the SUV to be 33 year old Cassie Jordan of the 1800 block Tulane Avenue in Shreveport. Upon contact with Jordan, police were able to recover the stolen package and return it to the home owner. Jordan, who was booked into the Shreveport City Jail, was arrested and charged with a single count of theft and contributing to the delinquency of a minor. The 13 year old teen was charged with a single count of theft.
