Suspect sought in robbery of fast food eatery



Robbery suspect

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking to identify and apprehend a suspect responsible for a hold-up of a fast food restaurant early Sunday morning in north Shreveport.

Just after 5:00 a.m. on December 4, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the Carl's Jr restaurant in the 100 block of Freestate Boulevard relative to an armed robbery of the business. On scene at the store, authorities made contact with an employee who was reportedly accosted by an armed man while attempting to open the store for business.

It is believed the suspect forced the employee inside the business at gunpoint and once inside, demanded he be given money from the store before leaving the business on foot. The man was described by witnesses as a light skinned male, dressed in all dark clothing, wearing a mask covering a portion of his face. The suspect wore gloves during the robbery and was armed with what appeared to be a small caliber handgun. Still images of the robbery suspect were obtained from the store's surveillance system and are being distributed in hopes of identifying the suspect responsible for the crime.
