Suspect sought in identity theft



Suspect in Identity Theft

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking to identify and apprehend a suspect responsible for stealing thousands of dollars after engaging in identity theft.

Between October 25th through 26th 2016, a unidentified man used fake documents to steal nearly \$17,000.00 after making withdrawals from local and out of state banks. The suspect was captured on video committing the crimes; however, authorities have not been able to determine the identity of the man nor his whereabouts.

Investigators believe the suspect somehow managed to gain access to the victim's personal information and produced fraudulent documents, identifying himself as the victim. The latest incident involving the suspect occurred at the Chase Bank located in the 9000 block of Mansfield Road back on October 26, in which the suspect again presented fraudulent documents to the employee in exchange for cash.
