## **Accused burglar nabbed by police**

A Shreveport man accused in a burglary committed last year, is now behind bars after video evidence linked him to the case.

Back on December 19, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the residential burglary of a home located in the 400 block of Egan Street. As officers arrived there, contact was made with the victim, who advised that upon his arrival home, he realized the front door to his home had been kicked in and items were removed from inside the residence. Unknown to the suspects, video surveillance of their deeds was captured and provided to police officers who have since worked tirelessly in their efforts to identify and apprehend the persons observed in the footage.

Since the investigation began, information was received indicating one of four suspects seen in the surveillance footage was possibly 27 year old Damarco Jones of Shreveport. Based on the video footage and other substantial evidence, investigators obtained a warrant for the arrest of Jones on charges of Principal to Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling. On Thursday February 9, 2017, Property Crimes detectives with the Shreveport Police Department, with the assistance of concerned citizens were able to locate Jones while he was mingling outside in the 400 block of Egan Street. Authorities contacted Jones and took him into police custody after he attempted to elude authorities on foot. Upon detectives interviewing of Jones, it was gathered that he engaged in an active role during the burglary of the victim's home back in December. For his alleged efforts, Jones, who was booked into the Shreveport City Jail, now faces additional charges of: Resisting an Officer, Simple Burglary and the outstanding warrant for Principal to Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling.
