Shreveport Police seek suspect in home invasion



Suspect Allen Martin

Shreveport Police are seeking to locate a man who has been linked to a home invasion robbery where one man was shot and another killed Thursday morning in west Shreveport.

Allen Martin 27, of the 6000 block of Lexington Avenue in Shreveport, is wanted by Shreveport Police for his alleged role in the matter, which left 43 year old Terry Stewart injured and another man, whose identity has not been released, deceased.

The incident took place at Stewart's home located in the 2400 block of Queens Highway, shortly before 2:00 a.m. on March 16, 2017. Authorities believe Martin and the now deceased victim, arrived at Stewart's home early Thursday morning and upon arrival there, produced guns in an apparent robbery of Stewart. Martin, following the incident, fled from the scene and remains outstanding. Police detectives have procured a warrant for the arrest of Martin, charging him with a single count of attempted second degree murder. Bond in the matter has been set at \$250,000.00.
