Pedestrian killed in north Shreveport crash

Shreveport Police Crash investigators are combing through evidence following a fatal accident involving a pedestrian in north Shreveport Monday evening.

At approximately 8:38 p.m. on March 20, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to the 4000 block of North Market Street (Highway 1) relative to a crash involving a pedestrian who had been struck by a motor vehicle traveling northbound on North Market Street near U.S. Highway 71. As officers arrived on scene, it was determined the victim, a 31 year old male was deceased at the scene.

The deceased, whose name was not immediately available, was apparently attempting to cross North Market Street from the west side of the roadway to the east, when he was struck by a 2009 Chevrolet pickup traveling northbound along North Market Street. The driver of the truck, 58 year old Doyle Daupin of Plain Dealing, Louisiana, remained on the scene and was taken to a local hospital where he submitted to mandatory toxicology testing as required by state law. While the crash remains under investigation, impairment was not immediately expected as a causative factor in the crash.
