Shreveport Police to hold safety checkpoint this weekend

The Shreveport Police Department's Traffic Bureau will hold a safety checkpoint this Friday night in west Shreveport

The checkpoint, which is part of the national "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" campaign, will begin at 10:00 p.m. on Friday, March 24, 2017 and run until 3:00 a.m. Saturday, March 25, 2017. The checkpoint is also part of a collaborative effort between multiple agencies to emphasize our commitment to make the streets of our city safe for everyone.

Officers will be checking for impaired drivers along with any other violations that could potentially compromise the safety of those persons taking to the roadways. Funding for the checkpoint is provided by a grant from the Louisiana Highway Safety Commission as part of the continuing effort to help curb the number of those impaired drivers who take to the streets each year in our area
