## **Warrant issued for suspect in shooting**

Shreveport Police detectives have issued a warrant for the arrest of a local teenager who is accused in a shooting which sent another man to the hospital late last month.

Back on March 26, 2017, Shreveport Police were called to the intersection of Downing Street at West 84th Street relative to a shooting. On officer's arrival there, it was learned that the victim, Sr'Derrick Wilson was suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the body after an argument in which a man exited a vehicle and shot him multiple times. It is believed that Wilson was walking near West 84th Street near Linwood Avenue when he encountered a male known to him sitting inside a vehicle. It is believed that after Wilson and the man exchanged words, a second man inside the car exited the vehicle and began firing shots.

Since the investigation began, authorities have worked non-stop in their efforts to identify the shooter. Continuous efforts by detectives, along with evidence gathered during their probe, has led them to name 17 year old Kesean Wilson of Shreveport (05/15/99) as the suspect in the shooting. Investigators believe Johnson fled the scene following the shooting and remains at large at this hour. Detectives have procured a warrant for Johnson's arrest, charging him with a single count of Attempted Second Degree Murder.
