## **Arrests Made in Overnight Burglary of C.E. Byrd High School**

Shreveport Police were dispatched to Byrd High School at 3201 Line Avenue just before 1:30am to investigate a burglary. When officers arrived on scene they were contacted by Caddo Parish School Board Security personnel and quickly confirmed that a burglary had taken place. Patrol officers immediately established a perimeter and began their search. The suspects were spotted nearby and a foot chase ensued. Three suspects, 17 year old Kenneth Morris, of the 2700 block of Barrett Street, and two juveniles were taken into custody and found to be in possession of the stolen merchandise as well as the tools used to effect the burglary.

Morris was booked into Shreveport City Jail and the two juveniles were booked into Caddo Parish Juvenile Detention Center. Each was charged with one count of Simple Burglary and one count of resisting arrest.
