Shreveport Police see leads in death of elderly man



Unidentified Suspect

Shreveport Police investigators are continuing their probe into a homicide that claimed the life of an Oklahoma man last week.

Just after 5:30 a.m. on May 5, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the intersection of Douglas Street at Travis street relative to the discovery of a deceased elderly man who was found suffering an apparent gunshot wound to the head. The man, identified as 70 year old Kenneth Clay Foshee of Broken Bow, Oklahoma, was observed sitting inside his truck by passing motorists, who subsequently notified authorities of the grisly find.

Since the launch of the investigation, detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit have been working tirelessly to piece together information relative to the crime and locate persons who might be able to provide some degree of insight as to what occurred leading up to the man's death. Investigators have been successful in obtaining surveillance video from a downtown business, which depicts an unidentified person, who appears to be a black female, reportedly observed speaking with Foshee during his final hours. Detectives are hopeful the person observed in the footage may be able to assist in the inquiry.
