Shreveport woman faces charges in slaying of elderly man

Shreveport Police detectives have charged a local woman for her alleged role in the shooting death of an Oklahoma man last week in downtown Shreveport.

Just after 5:30 a.m. on the morning of May 5, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the intersection of Douglas Street at Travis street relative to the discovery of a deceased elderly man who was found suffering an apparent gunshot wound to the head. The man, identified as 70 year old Kenneth Clay Foshee of Broken Bow, Oklahoma, was observed sitting inside his truck by passing motorists, who subsequently notified authorities of the grisly find.

Since the launch of the investigation, detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit have been working tirelessly to piece together information relative to the slaying and locate persons who might be able to provide some degree of insight as to what occurred leading up to Foshee's death. On Thursday May 11, 2017, Shreveport Police investigators were able to gather significant information leading them to procure a warrant for the arrest of a Shreveport woman, who based on evidence gathered, was linked to the murder of Foshee. Authorities arrived at the home of 35 year old Shemeka Jackson of the 700 block of Cotton Street in Shreveport, subsequently arresting her on the warrant charging her with Second Degree Murder. Following interviews with detectives, Jackson was booked into the Shreveport City Jail. Bond in the matter has been set at \$500,000.00.
