Suspect sought in shooting of local man



Suspect Lee Woodson

Shreveport Police are seeking to locate a man who has been linked to a shooting which sent another man to the hospital Sunday evening.

Just before 5:00 p.m. on May 21, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called Willis-Knighton South hospital relative to a man who arrived there suffering a single gunshot wound to the upper torso. It was learned in speaking with the victim, 28 year old Davariol Liggins, that he'd been shot allegedly by a male suspect who he had an earlier dispute with that afternoon. Following Liggins initial arrival at the emergency room, he was subsequently taken via ambulance, to University Health hospital for treatment of non-life-threatening injuries.

Shreveport Police investigating the crime have worked many hours in efforts to identify and apprehend the person responsible for the shooting. Further investigation and evidence has led authorities to name 28 year old Lee Woodson of Shreveport as a suspect in the crime. Investigators believe Woodson fired the shot striking Liggins, while the men were at Liggins's residence located in the 3700 block of Flora Street in west Shreveport. It is believed Woodson made forced entry inside the Flora Street home while being armed with a gun, and later attacked Liggins. Detectives have procured a warrant for the arrest of Woodson for his alleged role in the crime. Bond in the matter stands at \$100,000.00.
