



Shreveport man charged in May shooting



Suspect Demetris D. Crowley

A Shreveport man is now facing charges related to a shooting which left a local man injured last month.

Just after 11:00 p.m. on May 27, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to a shooting which occurred in the 8100 block of Pines Road. As officers arrived at the scene, they discovered the victim, 19 year old Trevon Harris suffering multiple gunshot wounds. It is believed Harris was shot while inside the residence, by suspects who fired guns from outside the home. Harris was transported via ambulance to University Health hospital, and continues to recover from his injuries.

Since the investigation into the shooting began, detectives from the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit have worked tirelessly to gather information regarding what occurred that evening and who was responsible. Through their efforts, evidence was gathered leading investigators to procure a warrant for the arrest of 19 year old Demetris D. Crowley. Crowley, of the 5600 block of Trevor Drive in Shreveport, was taken into police custody on June 5, 2017 after he was located at his workplace. Crowley now faces a charge of Attempted Second Degree Murder for his alleged role in the shooting. Following his arrest, Crowley was booked into the Shreveport City Jail. The investigation into the shooting continues.
