### **Man injured following overnight shooting in north Shreveport**

A local man is recovering from injuries he suffered after being shot late Saturday night during what is believed to be a robbery attempt in Shreveport's Highland neighborhood.

Just before midnight on June 10, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 100 block of Egan Street on reports of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located the victim, 26 year old Andrew Okray, suffering a gunshot wound to the upper left shoulder. Okray's injuries were reported as non-life-threatening and he was transported to University Health for treatment and is expected to make a full recovery.

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators were called to the scene and began their investigation. Preliminary information suggests that Okray was at his residence when an unknown suspect allegedly attempted to rob him. Okray fought with the suspect and the suspect fled. At that point, a possible second suspect began firing shots at Okray, striking him in the shoulder. Investigators are working at this hour to develop suspect information.
