Woman injured following early morning shooting

A local woman is recovering following an early morning shooting on Egan Street in Shreveport's Highland neighborhood.

Just before 12:30 a.m. on June 11, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to the 400 block of Egan Street on reports of a shooting. Officers arrived and located the victim, 31 year old Ashley Polk, suffering from a gunshot wound to her neck. Ashley was transported to University Health Hospital with what was reported to be non-life-threatening injuries.

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators were called to the scene and began their investigation. Preliminary information gathered at the scene suggests that Polk was inside of her residence when a small sedan stopped in front of the residence and unknown subject(s) began firing shots into the house striking Polk on the left side of the neck. Investigators are still working to identify suspects and motive for the shooting.
