Man suffers injury after interstate shooting

A Shreveport man is recovering after he was shot while driving along a stretch of Interstate 20 Monday morning.

Just before 5:00 a.m. on June 12, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a shooting along a stretch of Interstate 20 eastbound near the Common Street overpass. As officers arrived at the scene, it was learned the victim, 23 year old Perdarius Marshall was inside his vehicle suffering an apparent gunshot wound to the midsection. Marshall, who was conscious at the time of officer arrival, was transported via ambulance to University Health hospital for treatment of what was described as serious injury.

Preliminary information suggests Marshall was driving his vehicle along Interstate 20, when his car was struck by multiple rounds fired from another vehicle along the roadway. Evidence of the shooting was recovered from the roadway by responding officers. Marshall was able to call 911 before losing control of his car and subsequently crashing into the concrete barrier along the interstate. At current, there are no suspects in the shooting. Investigators with the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit are working feverishly at this hour to gather as much information as they can regarding the shooting.
