Warrant issued for May shooting suspect



Suspect Andrew Metoyer

Shreveport Police investigators are seeking to apprehend a male they believe is responsible for a shooting which left another man seriously injured in west Shreveport last month.

Just before 11:30 a.m. on May 24, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to the Texaco Quick Stop gas station located at the intersection of Jewella Avenue at Sunset Drive relative to reports a man had been shot there. As officers arrived, they discovered the victim, 30 year old Jereme Banks suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the body. Banks was rushed to University Health hospital for treatment of what was considered life-threatening injuries. Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives were notified of the shooting and arrived at the scene, immediately launching an investigation into the crime.

Based on information and evidence gathered at the scene, it appears Banks was standing outside the vehicle he was driving, when an unidentified man walked up to him in the gas station's parking lot and began firing multiple rounds striking Banks several times. Following the shooting, the man drove away in the vehicle in which Banks had previously occupied. Police located Bank's vehicle abandoned a short distance from the crime scene on Bellaire Avenue. Since the investigation into the shooting began, authorities have worked feverishly to gather information on who was responsible for the brazen crime. As a result of their hard work, detectives have gathered evidence leading them to name 31 year old Andrew Metoyer as a suspect in the shooting. Metoyer is now wanted on outstanding warrants charging him with a single count of Armed Robbery and Attempted First Degree Murder. Bond in the matter has been set at 550,000.00.
