Sibling dispute leads to gunfire



Suspect Felton Henderson

One man is behind bars, while another fights to recover after a dispute between family members ends in gunfire.

Just after 5:30 p.m. on June 14, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to an apartment home located in the 4200 block of Greenwood Lane relative to a shooting which occurred inside the residence. As officers arrived at the scene, they discovered the victim, 24 year old Christopher Green suffering a gunshot wound to the midsection. Green was taken by ambulance to University Health with injuries described as potentially life-threatening.

Shreveport Police investigators were called to the scene of the crime and immediately began their inquiry into the matter. Authorities detained 19 year old Felton Henderson on scene at the residence, after information was gathered he allegedly shot Green. It was further learned that Green and Henderson are siblings and were engaged in a verbal dispute when Henderson armed himself with a handgun and fired the weapon striking Green. Henderson was transported to Shreveport Police headquarters where he was interviewed by detectives relative to his alleged role in the shooting. Following subsequent interviews, Henderson was charged with a single count of Attempted Second Degree Murder and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
