Two slain in Sunday morning shooting

Shreveport Police homicide investigators are seeking information on an early morning shooting which left two people dead at a west Shreveport residence.

Just before 6:00 a.m. on June 18, 2017, Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a home located in the 3500 block of Junior Place relative to a shooting there. Upon officer's arrival at the scene, the bodies of a white male and female adult were discovered. Each victim was suffering at least a single gunshot wound to the body. Police discovered the female victim outside the home, while the male victim was located inside the residence. The identities of the victims is being withheld until appropriate notification of next of kin can be made.

Police detectives and crime scene investigators arrived at the home and immediately began the task of gathering information and evidence in the heinous crime. Based on preliminary findings, the shooting does not appear to be a random act and police suspect a person known to one or both victims may be responsible for the slayings. It is believed the shootings occurred at some point between late Saturday evening and early Sunday morning.
